 - Show your students the Be Smart-Don't Start Anti-Tobacco music video (<u>www.bit.ly/BeSmartDontStart</u>) in your classroom and discuss the purpose of the event.
 - Have your students participate in the passport activity at the museum. Passports will be provided to you on the day of the event when you check in. Students will need to visit various agency partners to learn more about the dangers of smoking and receive a stamp.
 - Participate in the check-out process, which includes completing an educator exit survey and having your students complete a short exit survey to indicate what they learned that day. All surveys must be turned in as part of the check-out process.
